**GOD: ALL DAY, EVERY DAY** 

Bottom Line: Live like you know God is with you.

**READ:** Psalm 16:8 (NIrV) - I know that the LORD is always with me. He is at my right hand. I will always be secure.

Although we can't see Him, God is always there. Close your eyes and imagine a day with God by your side. How would you feel? What would you do? Grab some paper and a writing utensil and draw a picture of your day with God.

**ASK** God to help you remember daily that you are never alone. Pray a prayer like this:

"Dear God, I know You are always there, but please help me to remember that You are there even when I feel alone. I love You God. Amen."
