

Talk About It

Read Romans 8:5-16

1. Observe and list the different truths presented about the Holy Spirit.

2. Which of these is really standing out to you that you need to pay attention to; do you have questions, conviction, or encouragement from what God is highlighting in this passage about the Holy Spirit?

Read 2 Kings 6:8-17

1. How does the servant represent the difference between knowing about God and experiencing His loving presence?

2. If Jesus said the Greatest Commandment is to love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, how do we move beyond head knowledge to a living relationship with Him that also impacts our heart and soul? Does anyone in your group have examples of when the Holy Spirit's work in the supernatural realm became evident and you were awakened to that spiritual reality (dreams, words, visions, miracles, answers to prayer, or unusual provision from God)?

3.Are you scared or skeptical about experiencing the supernatural realm through the Spirit? Can you trust God even when it's a new experience?

Read 2 Kings <u>6:18-23</u>

1. Do you agree that the ending to this story is surprising? Why or why not?

2. Why is it so hard for us to be merciful in the realm of the flesh? Read Luke 6:32-3 3. How do we plug into the source of this kind of supernatural love?

PRAYER: Pray for the person on your left to become more aware of God's love at work in the realm of the Spirit, pray for us as a church to be a people transformed by knowing and supernaturally experiencing God's grace and mercy personally.
