Talk about it:

What's one problem or thing in the world you really wish could be solved or changed?

Have you ever encountered a really difficult physical/medical circumstance? How did/does your faith in Jesus help you keep a hopeful perspective?

Read Romans 8:18-25

How do you see "creation groaning" today? What kind of evidence do we live with that this is a fallen world? As stewards of the creation what should we be doing now to care for it and work toward seeing God's will be done on earth as in heaven?

Read Revelation 21:1-4, 22-27

Discuss what our reality will be when Jesus returns; list the things that John sees in his vision of the future. What do you most look forward to when all creation is restored?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:24-26

Observe the WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, WHY of these verses. If you believe this to be true, how should you respond today?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-49

It what ways have you put too much hope in this perishable body? Would you admit to putting more energy into bodily comfort or appearance than serving God at times? How do we balance being good stewards of the body God's given us with knowing these bodies are limited, weak at times, and temporary?

Read Revelation 22:1-5.

What does it mean, according to these verses, when Pastor Kaye says hope coming brings our victory party and full inheritance?

Pray that God will increase your longing for full redemption and thank Him that everything sad is coming untrue!
