Read and discuss [2 Corinthians 1:18-22](#) and [Joshua 1:1-3](#).

According to [2 Corinthians 1:20](#) "No matter how many promises God has made they are yes in Christ" What are some promises from the Lord to you? Have you struggled to believe those promises are still valid? Why or why not?

[Joshua 1:2](#) uses the phrase "get ready" How can you get ready for God's promises to be fulfilled in your life? (Ex. Noah built an ark before it rained.) What stands out to you about God's promises in [Joshua 1:1-3](#)

Read and discuss [Joshua 1:4-9](#)

Why do you think the Lord reminds Joshua repeatedly to be bold? What is God telling you to be bold about? In [verses 4-9](#) how many times can you count the Lord encouraging Joshua? Where are they?

How does the Lord encourage you? Are you feeling encouraged or discouraged right now? What is the pre-requisite being prosperous and successful for Joshua? How has the Word of God made you successful?

Read and discuss [Joshua 1:10-18](#) re-read [16-18](#)

The Israelites went 'all in' with their response to Joshua and his leadership; discuss why this must have been difficult for them.

Who do you have in your life that would give you this type of response: "Whoever rebels against you will be put to death"? In other words, who on your team believes in you like the Israelites believed in Joshua? Do you have the right people on your team right now? How important is having the right team to our success in the faith?
