Key Scriptures:

Ephesians 4:1-6

Romans 16:3-16

Main Idea: Embrace your Kingdom Connection

1. Embrace your Kingdom Connection by Knowing Names.
2. Embrace your Kingdom Connection by Saying Hello.
3. Embrace your Kingdom Connection by Embracing Kingdom Affection.

Talk About it:

Ice Breaker: Do you remember your first kiss? On scale of 1-10 how awkward was it?

Read and discuss Ephesians 4:1-6:

What does it look like to “Live a life worthy of the calling you have”? What is the “calling you have” that Paul is referring to? What are some ways you are living life that way? Where can you improve? What does it look like to “bear with one another in love”?

Read and discuss Romans 16:3-6:

Why would it be significant that Paul in this list of names mentions Jews, Greeks, males, females, slaves, and leaders? Have you ever been recognized by name by someone who you didn't know you? How did that feel? Do you feel you know many people by name at Sage Hills Church? Have you seen the impact of a cheerful greeting from someone during a tough time? What did you notice about how their attitude effected yours? Do you categorize yourself as a hugger? Why is physical touch uncomfortable to some? What are some ways you think the church could “Redeem touch”?

Close this week hearing from one another's prayer request, take time to place each request before the Lord.
