Main Idea: Address your prayers accordingly...

Address them to the Father.

Address them to Heaven.

Address them with honor.

Talk about it... Ice Breaker: If your life were going to be made into a movie; what genre of movie would it be? What would the title be? Who would play you?

Read and Discuss Matthew 6:5-14

In reading these verses what did you as a group glean from them?

What stood out to you as amazing? What was challenging and why?

Read Matthew 6:9

1. Why do you think Jesus tells us to begin our Prayer with OUR FATHER? How has God revealed himself to you as Father? Is it challenging for you to call God father? Why or why not? This weekend we talked about addressing your prayers accordingly how is addressing your prayer to Father different than praying to a problem?
2. Why is it important to address your prayers to your father who is in HEAVEN? What excites you most about Heaven? What is powerful about the fact that our **father is in Heaven**?
3. The word hallowed means HOLY, set apart, and sacred. Why is important in our prayers to remember that the Lord's name is hallowed? How can you introduce some hallowedness into your prayers? As a result of reading just Matthew 6:9 what will change about the way you pray?
