

Week #6 Notes

Main Idea: DWELL in the Kingdom, MOVE in POWER, and GIVE GOD the Glory.

I dwell in the <u>kingdom</u> when I allow Jesus to be <u>KING of my HEART</u>. I move in <u>KINGDOM POWER</u> when I <u>RECLAIM lost land and lives</u>. I bring <u>GOD GLORY</u> when <u>I MOVE IN FAITH</u>.

Matthew 6:5-13 (NASB)

5 "When you pray, you are not to be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. 6 But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees *what is done* in secret will reward you.

7 "And when you are praying, do not use meaningless repetition as the Gentiles do, for they suppose that they will be heard for their many words. 8 So do not be like them; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

9 "Pray, then, in this way:

'Our Father who is in heaven,

Hallowed be Your name.

'Your kingdom come.

Your will be done,

On earth as it is in heaven.

'Give us this day our daily bread.

'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.'

Matthew 6:13b

For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.'

DWELL in the Kingdom, MOVE in POWER, and GIVE GOD the Glory.

1 Chronicles 29:11 (NIV)

Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power

and the glory and the majesty and the splendor,

for everything in heaven and earth is yours.

Yours, Lord, is the kingdom;

you are exalted as head over all.

2 Corinthians 4:4 (NLT)

Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.

I dwell in the kingdom when I allow Jesus to be KING of my HEART.



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Psalm 125:1-2 New International Version (NIV) Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever.

As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds his people both now and forevermore.

I move in KINGDOM POWER when I RECLAIM lost land and lives.

Psalm 125:3 New International Version (NIV) The scepter of the wicked will not remain over the land allotted to the righteous, for then the righteous might use their hands to do evil.

I bring GOD GLORY when I MOVE IN FAITH.

Hebrews 11:6 New International Version (NIV)

6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

1 Corinthians <u>10:31</u> New International Version (NIV) 31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God

Talk about it:

Ice Breaker: What would you say is the biggest victory moment in your life? (You can make it spiritual or just fun) Describe the victory? Why was it so meaningful?

Read and Discuss Matthew 6:5-13 Use the NEW AMERICAN STANDARD VERSION if available or KING JAMES... If not available add the line [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.']

As you read these verses what stands out to you?

Read aloud Matthew 6:13 and 2 Corinthians 4:4

How have you experienced victory from the evil one? How have you seen or experienced the enemy veiling the eyes of non-believers? The last statement in the Lord's Prayer as it exists in liturgical form is "For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever. AMEN."



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Is there anything confusing to you when you read that? Do any of those three things (kingdom, power, glory) seem difficult for you to announce <u>today</u> as truth statements? Why or why not? Have you ever felt like for a season any of those three things where clouded by the "god of this world"? When?

Read Psalms 125:1-3

How does the enemy try to shake you? How have you experienced what Psalms 125:1 promises (which cannot be shaken)? What are some areas of your life right now that you feel the Lord is surrounding you? What are some areas where you feel need covering?

When you hear, "Land allotted to the righteous" what comes to your mind? Who are some people you feel the enemy has placed his scepter over? How can you help them remove it? Conclude your group praying for one another, ask the Lord for opportunities to DWELL in the Kingdom, MOVE in POWER, and GIVE HIM the Glory

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
