Main Idea: Close the Gap between your intentions and your actions...

A)When you **SEE SOMETHING GOOD** say

Women: Pursue you man with words of

SOMETHING GOOD.

Men: Pursue your Woman with words of affection.

What makes you feel pursued? Do you feel a gap between your intentions and actions? What are some ways you can close that gap?
