Key Scriptures:

Main Idea: Partner with the Poet and His Poetry

Talk about it:

Ice Breaker: How have you been doing in closing the gap between your intentions and your actions? How do you currently partner with your spouse?

Read Ephesians 2:8-10

How do you see God making poetry in your life? How can you compose with your Creator's creativity in your life? Family? Work? Other places?

Read Ephesians 5:18-33

As we went through this passage on Sunday, we reflected on the call to be filled with the Spirit through mutual submission, love and respect. How can you practice co-leadership in your marriage and relationships?
