Key Scriptures:

Isaiah 9:6, Philippians 4:1-8

Isaiah 9:6 New International Version (NIV)

⁶ For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders.

And he will be called

Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace**.

Main Idea: Pursue Christ's <u>provision of</u> Peace...

Philippians 4:7 New International Version (NIV)

⁷ And the **peace of God**, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:9 New International Version (NIV)

⁹ Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the **God** of peace will be with you.

Philippians 4:1 New International Version (NIV)

4 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!

1) Pursue Christ's provision of Peace by STANDING FIRM...

Philippians 4:2-3 New International Version (NIV)

² I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to **be**of the same mind in the Lord. ³ Yes, and I ask you,
my true companion, help these women since they
have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel,
along with Clement and the rest of my coworkers, whose names are in the book of life.

2) Pursue Christ's provision of Peace by STANDING TOGETHER...

Philippians 4:4-7 New International Version (NIV)

⁴Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again:
Rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The
Lord is near. ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but
in every situation, by prayer and petition, with
thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And
the peace of God, which transcends all
understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds
in Christ Jesus.

3) Pursue Christ's provision of Peace by STANDING IN JOY...

Philippians 4:8-9 New International Version (NIV)

⁸ Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true,
whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is
pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if
anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about
such things. ⁹ Whatever you have learned or received
or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into
practice. And the God of peace will be with you.
